Dear friends and family,

Greetings from beautiful Florida! We are getting ready for take-off to Cuba and have been with our dear friends and co-laborers Frank and Jeannette Meitz for the last few days, getting details and prep taken care of.



On Sunday we were privileged to share in a bi-lingual service at their church. Pablo preached, I translated, there was a Cuban worship team that led music, and we got to meet our 5th member of the team: Liz Miniter, as we were prayed over and sent out!

We are so excited to share some amazing miracles happening! We have already received our religious visas to enter the country! Sometimes it is until the last day that we receive the news, so we are thrilled to know they are approved and ready for our arrival. Another very exciting thing is that in the beginning of August a cargo ship took off from Jacksonville, FL with

a pallet for the DTI conference! The pallet contained 1,000 DTI Manuals





and 700 pounds of dry food. It arrived in Cuba 2 ½ days later! Since then, it

has been held to clear customs. We have been praying and praying for this process as we were told it sometimes can take up to three months. Last night we got the news that it has been released and we will pick up the shipment on our way to the conference in Pinar del Rio this coming Friday!

Wow! We are jumping up and down and so thankful for God's hand on every detail!

We shared in our last newsletter about the very physical needs, the rolling blackouts across the island, the lack of gasoline, medicines, glasses, basic foods, and so much

more... As we get closer to our departure, we now have packed 11 -50 lb suitcases and 5 VERY HEAVY carryon's to take. Three of ours are filled with medicines and prescription glasses that were donated by St. Barnabas Mexico

Medical Mission, as well as other donated and purchased meds, bibles and clothing gifts!

Yesterday we worked on the

schedules ! and lining out which professor will do what! It is all shaping up! We are expecting 100

pastors and leaders at the Discipler Training

conference and ask you to pray for each one as they are equipped and challenged to disciple (mentor, nurture) new believers and older believers that are not growing – as well as taking their learning back to

their churches to train their leadership to disciple others. Pray for growth and conviction and God's provision for every need.



The conference location in Pinar del Rio






